



## MOCK TEST NOTIFICATION CSIR -UGC National Eligibility Test (NET)

### Important Dates:

Mock Test Date: **28.11.2010**

Last Date for application: **05.11.2010**

1. Panjab University will hold **Mock Test** for CSIR-UGC National Eligibility Test (NET) (Sciences) on **28<sup>th</sup> November, 2010.**

2. **SUBJECTS:** The Test will be held in the following subjects:

1. *Chemical Sciences;*
2. *Earth Atmospheric Ocean and Planetary Sciences;*
3. *Life Sciences;*
4. *Mathematical Sciences;*
5. *Physical Sciences.*

### **3. CONDITIONS OF ELIGIBILITY:**

Candidates who have passed M.Sc. or Equivalent degree in the above subjects, with minimum 55% marks for General & OBC candidates & 50% for Scheduled Caste (SC) / Schedule Tribe (ST), Physically Handicapped (PH) and Visually Handicapped (VH) candidates and Ph.D. degree holders who had passed Master's degree prior to 19<sup>th</sup> September, 1991 are eligible for the mock test. Candidates appearing or having appeared in the final year of M.Sc. or equivalent Degree Examination, in subjects mentioned above, during the academic Session 2010-2011 can also apply.

### **4. EXAMINATION FEE:**

The examination fee for the Mock Test would be **Rs.100/-** for the students studying at Panjab University during the session 2010-11 and **Rs.250/-** for others.

### **5. SCHEME AND DATE OF TEST:**

The CSIR-UGC (NET) MOCK TEST shall comprise 2 papers, PAPER-I & PAPER-II. Both the papers will be

held on 28<sup>th</sup> November, 2010 in two separate sessions as under:

**PAPER I:** This paper shall be of 2 hours and 30 minutes duration and shall have a maximum of 200 marks. This paper will consist of two sections.

Part 'A' of Paper I shall contain 40 General Science questions. *These questions shall be common to all subject areas of CSIR-UGC NET Mock Test.* A candidate shall be required to answer a maximum of 25 questions from Part 'A'. In case, a candidate answers more than 25 questions, only the first 25 answered questions will be taken up for evaluation.

Part 'B' of Paper I shall have 100 questions. A candidate shall be required to answer a maximum of 75 questions. In case a candidate answers more than 75 questions, only the first 75 answered questions shall be evaluated. All questions shall be of **two marks** each. ***There will be negative marking (25%) for wrong answers.***

**PAPER II:** This paper shall be of 2 hours and 30 minutes duration and

shall have a maximum of 200 marks. This Paper shall consist of 35-40 short answer type questions requiring descriptive answers. Questions No. 1 shall be compulsory and carry 20 marks. In addition to the compulsory questions, the candidate is required to answer a maximum of 12 questions of 15 marks each. To answer each question, a candidate will be provided one page for each answer.

Candidates are required to appear in both the papers. A candidate who does not appear in Paper I will not be permitted to appear in Paper II.

The Test booklet for this Mock Test will be printed in Hindi & English Version separately. The candidate opting for Hindi Medium in Column No.4 of the Mock Test Application Form, will be supplied Test Booklet printed in Hindi Version only and candidates opting for English Medium will be supplied Test Booklet printed in English Version only. *The candidate will be required to answer as per option exercised in Column No. 4 of Application Form.* In case of any discrepancy found in the English and Hindi versions, the questions in English version shall be taken as final.

**6. For Visually Handicapped (VH) candidates** thirty minutes extra time shall be provided for Paper-I & forty five minutes' extra time

for Paper-II. They will also be provided the services of a scribe who would be a graduate in a subject other than that of the candidate. Those **Physically Handicapped (PH)** candidates who are not in a position to write in their own hand-writing can also avail these services by submitting prior request, in writing along with the application form, to the coordinator of the test. Extra time and facility of scribe would not be provided to other Physically Handicapped candidates.

**7. SYLLABI OF TEST:** The syllabus of Paper I (Section A), subject-wise syllabus of Paper I (Section B) and Paper II can be seen at CSIR website: [www.csirhrdg.res.in](http://www.csirhrdg.res.in).

#### **8. THE TEST CENTRES:**

The Mock Test would be conducted at the Panjab University Campus only. The candidates are advised to check Panjab University website <http://puchd.ac.in> on or after **19.11.2010** for allotment of their test centre on the Panjab University Campus.

#### **9. HOW TO APPLY:**

(i) Prescribed application form is available from the Coordinator, CSIR-UGC-NET (Sciences) and can also be downloaded from the P.U. website <http://puchd.ac.in>. Completed application form should reach the Honorary Director, Centre for IAS and other Competitive Examinations, Panjab University, Chandigarh along with requisite fee in cash or demand draft (in favour of **Coordinator, CSIR-UGC NET 2010**) by **05-11-2010 (Friday)** positively.

(ii) Applicants sending their applications through post may note that the envelope containing the Application Form be subscribed **"CSIR-UGC NET MOCK TEST (Sciences) 2010."**

(iii) Students who are studying in Panjab University for the qualifying examination for the session 2010-2011 should attach a copy of the proof (attested copy of identity card/ certificate from head of department/ Institution).

(iii) The candidate must affix their recent identical passport size photographs, at the places indicated, in the Application Form and Admit Card.

(iv) Candidates are advised to fill in their E-mail addresses along with mobile numbers in the address column of the Form.

#### **8. GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS:**

1. Candidate must bring his/her Admit Card at the Examination Centre failing which candidate will not be allowed to enter the Examination Hall.
2. The Admit Card is non-transferable. No request for change of Examination Centre will be entertained under any circumstances.
3. There **will be negative marking** (25%) for wrong answer in Paper-I.
4. The answers of the questions are to be marked in the OMR Answer Sheet with **BLACK BALL POINT PEN ONLY**.
5. Candidates should reach the Examination Centre at least 30 minutes before the scheduled time of conduct of the examination.
6. No candidate is allowed to enter the examination hall

after schedule time of examination and also not allowed to leave the examination hall before completion of examination.

7. Candidate is strictly prohibited to carry electronic devices like calculator, cellular phone, pager, digital diary, log tables, etc. in the examination hall.

8. Candidate who does not appear in Paper-I, will not be permitted to appear in Paper-II

9. Candidates should ensure that the signatures appended and photographs pasted by them in all the places, viz. in their Application Form and Admit Card should be identical and there should be no variation of any kind.

10. Candidates who do not receive or have misplaced their admit cards are advised to download it from the P. U. website <http://puchd.ac.in>. They should paste a photo on the card and bring fee receipt/ photocopy of demand draft on the day of the test (*check your centre at P.U. website on or after 19.11.10*). They should report, one hour before the commencement of the test, to the Superintendent of Test Centre for issuing of Duplicate Admit Card on production of identity proof (Identity card/ Driving License).
